Release and Indemnification

I hereby agree to indemnify and hold Seattle Asian Sports Club (SASC) harmless from any claims of any nature or kind suffered by any member of my family relating to his/her/our/their participation in any SASC activity. I understand that this means that I am releasing and waiving any and all claims for injury or damages my child or family member may have against SASC and that I will be solely responsible for paying all costs incurred by SASC resulting from any such claim, such as medical/dental costs or attorney's fees. The instant agreement to release and indemnify SASC includes, without limitation, the organization itself and its coaches, volunteers, board members and officers.

SASC Registration Information

Priority Registration

Players in good standing may submit his/her registration form prior to July 1.

“Good Standing”

A player is considered to be in “good standing” if,

1. S/he was on an official SASC team roster for the previous program year.
2. All registration fees for the previous program year are paid in full.
3. Last program year’s team jersey has been returned or paid for.
4. Returning players who are “not in good standing” may be refused registration, until his/her “good standing” is reinstated. Registration will be considered effective as of this date.

Open Registration

Open Registration for SASC is for all interested players who did not participate the previous program year. For them, formal registration begins July 1. Any registration form received from a non-returning player prior to July 1, will be considered to be received on July 1.

Any registration forms received from players not in “good standing,” prior to July 1, shall be considered to have submitted their registration effective the date when “good standing” is restored.

Waiting List

SASC currently is committed to have one team at each age/gender level. Each team shall have a minimum of seven (7) players and a maximum of ten (10) players.

If any one team shall have more than ten players initially registered, all registrants over ten (11,12,13,14,etc.) shall be placed on a waiting list in rank order according to date of online registration or postmark of mail-in registration.

If space on a roster opens up, an offer will be made to registrants on the waiting list in rank order.

In the event that one or more registrants are “tied” in rank order, offer(s) shall be determined by lottery from among those registrants who are “tied.”

Refund Policy—Requests for refunds must be submitted to the Registrar@SASCsports.org by the appropriate deadline below.

Full Refund: If you register, then decide to drop on or before July 31.

Partial Refund (full membership minus \$75):

1. If you register and you decide to drop by October 31, whether or not you participated in summer.
2. If you register and there is no roster space for you after October 31, whether or not you participated in summer
3. If you register, make your high school team and decide to drop by November 15, whether or not you participated in summer.
4. If family registered more than one player, refunds will be processed from least to most expensive (ie, sibling before primary).

Withdrawal After #1, #2 and #3 above: No refunds.

Attendance at Practice & Playing Time

It is the position of SASC that attendance at practice is critical to both individual and team success. SASC expects players to make every effort to attend all practices and games. Attendance at practice will have a direct impact on playing time. Check with your head coach for his/her specific attendance policy.

Multiple Team Participation

Players who play for multiple teams face the dilemma of adequate participation in SASC team practices and games. We understand that contemporary family life is full of choices and competing activities. By becoming a member of SASC, we assume that you and your child believe the SASC program will benefit the development and growth of your child. We expect you are committed to participating fully and that SASC is a high priority in the extracurricular life of your child.

Impact of Select Team Players on SASC Team Placement in League Play. The Seattle Parks and Recreation (SPAR) 2009 Youth Basketball Rule Book states that, if a single player on a SPAR team roster also plays for a select or traveling team, the SPAR team, of which he or she is a member must be entered at the Gold Division level. What this means is that if your child plays on a select team or traveling team in another league, and is also on the roster of a SASC team, that SASC team must be entered in the Gold Division level, regardless of the skill level of the other players on that particular SASC team.

Financial Assistance

SASC has a limited number of financial aid opportunities for low-income families to assist with defraying the cost of registration fees. A Financial Aid Request Form must be submitted along with each player’s registration form. Online registrants must mail in the Financial Assistance application within 10 days to hold their registration position.
